

Imitated but Never Duplicated

There's a bit of engineering magic to the Dryerbox[®] that makes for a cleaner, more professional looking finish. A couple of the patented secrets to this magic can be seen in the angled base of the Dryerbox[®]—which starts from the floor plate—and the drywall extension rim. Recently, a company tried to duplicate this Dryerbox[®] magic, but they can not include these important features because of patent protection. The illustrations below clearly show why attempted imitation, while sometimes flattering, is never as good as the real thing.



Dryerbox[®] Advantage

Design allows for installation down to the floor so the flex hose can sweep cleanly into the Dryerbox[®].

Extension rim provides a reveal to make an exact baseboard finish easy.

Always install the Dryerbox[®] for a cleaner, more professional finish.

Imitator Design Problems

Trim ring forces contractors to install several inches above the floor (as is also indicated in instructions). Above the baseboard, overhang of flex hose creates a crush-point and the dryer has to be placed further from the wall.

The trim ring also competes with the finished floor and makes baseboard installation a guessing game.
